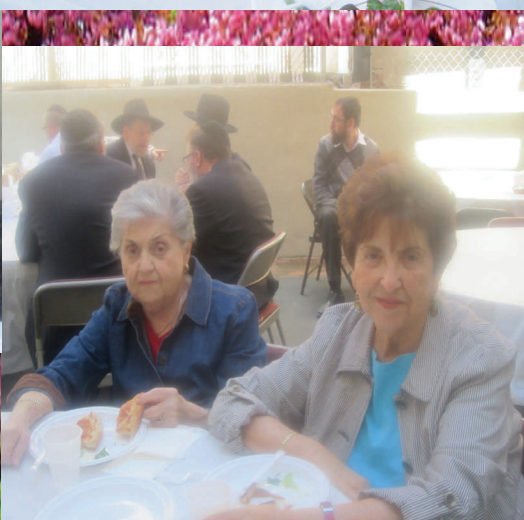
She immediately replies, "The red-head in the middle."
